
We're not 100% there yet (probably 95%!) but as you will see we have made excellent progress and most importantly we now have firm commitments from all of our *major* suppliers.

As you all know we have had to contend with some significant changes to our T50 Programme but we are *fairly confident* that we will be able to deliver each of the T50 French Tours within the quoted prices. Thus 'Final bills' will be sent to you mid-January and will be due for settlement by the end of January. [Please note (a) that we will notify you immediately if there are any changes to costs post final bills. Those that could arise, although unlikely, amount to no more than 3% of the total cost of your Tour (b) that we are unable to refund deposits for any cancellations to the Tours since we have now paid deposits to all of our major suppliers and each of our tours carries group overheads that have been shared across all participants.]

Final 'joining instructions' for all events will be sent to you via email by the end of April 2014.

T50 NORMANDY DD LANDINGS TOUR 30th June – 3rd July

Recommended arrival time: 5 p.m.












T50 Chateaux and Vineyards of the Loire Tour July 7th – 10th



Our apologies that it has taken quite so long to reconstruct the itinerary for the T50 Chateaux and Vineyards of the Loire Tour. As you know from previous communications we were thwarted by the owner of Chateau RiveSarthe who had offered us some <u>very</u> advantageous room rates for extending our stay at Chateau Rivesarthe after the Classic Le Mans Tour. (Not so advantageous I hear you say when the owner reneged on his commitments!) Then came the next blow – a change in dates for Classic Le Mans which thwarted our aim to ensure that guests could join in the 4th July Bastille Night celebrations!

So our challenge was to create a brand new format tour within the original quoted costs for the trip, encompassing as much as possible of our original tour.

Malcolm Sedman has worked hard to re-create the trip and we are delighted that we are now able to detail it to you.

As well as visiting two of the originally stated Chateaux and Vineyards, guests will have the opportunity to spend a whole day visiting a little known but

As well as visiting two of the originally stated Chateaux and Vineyards, guests will have the opportunity to spend a whole day visiting a little known but unique Chateau – Chateau Pimpean – where 'mine host' awaits the party to provide a guided tour, wine tasting and lunch.

Monday 7th July

Depart your Hotels/Gites at leisure in time to meet up with the whole group at one of the fascinating Saumur Caves* at 1300 to enjoy a typical French lunch (included in the package).

Driving time from Le Mans hotels maximum 2 hours. (Recommended scenic routes avoiding Autoroutes will be provided.)

Take the opportunity whilst you are there to visit the Caves and Vineyards (small entrance fee payable).

*We are currently awaiting confirmation from our chosen Saumur Cave and will let you know as soon as we receive it.



Monday 7 th July	Depart Saumur at approximately 1530 for a gentle drive on to our hotel - Hotel Kyriad, Tours 'Sud', which will be our base for the duration of our visit. Arrive Hotel Kyriad approximately 1700 hours Dinner including wine in the hotel.	
Tuesday 8 th July	Today we spend the day at Chateau de Pimpean, a family owned Chateau, originally built by Bertrand de Beauvau, friend of King Rene in 1435. You will be transported to the Chateau by coach (100 kilometres from your hotel) so that you can enjoy the wine tasting and your lunch without worrying about drinking and driving! Depart Hotel 0930 (tbc) Guided Tour, Wine Tasting, Lunch at Chateau de Pimpean and the opportunity to buy wine direct from the Chateau. Return Hotel 1700 (tbc) Dinner including wine in the hotel.
